MEMBERSHIP POLICY

1. To become a Member of The Ethics of the Cosmos International Social Movement for the Promotion of Peaceful Existence in Outer Space (the Movement) one has to get familiar with the Preamble and the Declaration of the Movement, express his/her agreement with what is written in these documents, and provide the following information about himself/herself by e-mail, in English:
 - full name;
 - city and country of residence;
 - titles, scientific degrees, positions in other organizations, if one has any, and/or what one does, his/her profession (optional);
 - a photograph, preferably headshot (optional).
2. No later than two weeks after performing the specified actions the applicant receives by e-mail his/her Certificate of Membership in the Ethics of the Cosmos International Social Movement signed by the Head of the Movement and the Chief Coordinator of the Movement, in a PDF form.
3. By agreement with the Chief Coordinator of the Movement, the new Member may be given the title of a Representative of the Movement in the country of his/her residence or he/she is a citizen of, as well as the new Member may be given the title of an Honorary Member of the Movement or other appropriate titles.
4. By providing information about himself/herself, one thereby gives his/her consent to the posting of the information sent by him/her, including photo, on the website and in the social network accounts of the Movement in order to achieve the goals of the Movement recorded in its Declaration.
5. At any time, a Member of the Movement may request the management of the Movement to amend (correct, update, delete) the information about himself/herself, posted on the website and/or in the social network accounts of the Movement, by providing new data about himself/herself and/or clear instructions on what shall be changed, via e-mail. The management of the Movement undertakes to make the changes within no more than 2 weeks from the date of receipt of the request.
6. Membership in The Ethics of the Cosmos is free of charge.

7. Members of the Movement have the right to:
 - 7.1. Be informed of and participate in the activities of the Movement, planned and ongoing.
 - 7.2. Spread information about the Movement, including sharing its website, YouTube channel and social network accounts with other people.
 - 7.3. Invite those interested in the Movement's activities to apply for the Membership in the Movement.
 - 7.4. Make suggestions to the management of the Movement on the directions of the Movement's activities.
 - 7.5. Provide their works, videos, photographs, audio and other relevant data to be posted on the website, YouTube channel and in the social network accounts of the Movement, as long as the materials being provided serve the achievement of the goals of the Movement stated in its Declaration.
 - 7.6. Donate to the Movement.

8. Membership termination.
 - 8.1. If a Member wants to terminate his/her Membership in The Ethics of the Cosmos, he/she must inform the management of the Movement about his/her decision by e-mail.
 - 8.2. The management of the Movement shall execute the request of the Member within no more than 2 weeks from the date of receipt of the relevant e-mail from the Member by sending him/her back a confirmation letter that his/her Membership in The Ethics of the Cosmos has been terminated.
 - 8.3. No later than two weeks from the date the confirmation letter has been sent to the ex-Member, appropriate changes shall be made to the website and social network accounts of the Movement, e.g. the ex-Member's profile in the "Members" section of the website of the Movement, shall be deleted.
 - 8.4. No donations made by the ex-Member during his Membership in The Ethics of the Cosmos are given back.
